

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. The competition is open to amateurs only.
- 2. Age to be established as at the first day of the Eisteddfod.

3. Repertoire

- o All music selected for AMEB Grade sections (except Novice) must be chosen from the current AMEB syllabus.
- o One piece only to be played, apart from Recital and Ensembles sections.
- o No repeats are to be played.
- o Only one grade section per instrument may be entered.
- o Repertoire played or used in any section cannot be repeated in any other section.
- 4. Competitors must provide their own accompanist. Accompanist entry fee is included in enrolment fee.
- 5. Automated accompanists e.g CDs, tapes, electronic instruments are not permitted. Microphones are not permitted.
- 6. **Time limits** must be strictly adhered to. The times stated are the maximum times allowed for each item. Failure to observe time limits may result in disqualification.

7. Photocopies

- o Original scores (NOT photocopies) must be used for all performances. Failure to observe this rule may result in disqualification.
- o All competitors must upload a copy of their performance music at the time of enrolment. Failure to observe this rule may result in disqualification.
- o Photocopies are for Adjudicator's use only (permitted by APRA AMCOS) and will not be returned.

8. Trophies

- o A trophy will be awarded to the winner in each section, except when there are less than three competitors. In such cases the adjudicator is authorised to use their discretion.
- o FIRST PRIZE a minimum of 85 marks
- o SECOND PRIZE a minimum of 80 marks
- o The adjudicator has the right to withhold an award in any section where sufficient merit has not been displayed and the performance is not of the required standard.
- 9. If there are insufficient entries in any section, the section may be cancelled and money refunded, or two or more categories combined. No other refunds will be made.
- 10. Any protests must be made in writing within one hour of the completion of the section along with \$50, which will be forfeited if the protest is deemed invalid. The decision of the adjudicator and committee in all questions and disputes is final.
- 11. No entry to, or exit from the hall will be permitted during a performance.
- 12. Although every care will be taken, the committee will not accept responsibility for accidents or for belongings left at the Eisteddfod venue.
- 13. Photography and videography is permitted for your own performance only.
- 14. All mobile phones must be switched off or set to silent.

15. Closing Date

- o Entries must be received by the date stated on the most recent schedule.
- o All late entries may be charged a fee of \$10 and accepted only at committee discretion

16. Winners' Concert

- o Selected winners will be invited to perform at the Winners' Concert.
- o All first and second prize winners will be invited to the Winners' Concert to receive their award.

Christopher Latham Memorial Prize


We are honored to announce the establishment of the Christopher Latham Memorial Prize, kindly supported by the Latham family and the Australian Music Examination Board (AMEB).

We have created this special prize in memory of Christopher who was known for his unwavering commitment and dedication to this Eisteddfod and his encouragement of young performers to achieve their best in music.

The Christopher Latham Memorial Prize will be awarded annually in two categories:

- Junior: Perpetual Trophy + \$100 + \$50 Zenith Music Voucher (for musicians aged 13 and under)
- Senior: Perpetual Trophy + \$200 + \$100 Zenith Music Voucher (for musicians aged 14 and over)

This award aims to recognise and encourage exceptional performers who demonstrate a clear understanding of musical expression and stylistic elements relevant to their works, creativity and passion in their playing. All competitors across all instruments are eligible. The award recipients will be nominated by adjudicators and the Prize will be presented at the Winner's Concert.




